

LEAD CLIMBING MULTI-PITCH COURSE
NATIONALLY ACCREDITED TRAINING

The Multi-pitch Lead Climbing Course is designed to give you the knowledge and skills to climb a route using traditional techniques, on-sight from the ground up. Training covers selection of equipment, guide book interpretation, using removable protection (cams, wires, nuts etc), rope management, belay systems (including hanging belays), climbing techniques, safety calls, double rope techniques, and retreating from a route.

Duration: Three (3) days nominal (may vary according to individual aptitude)

Enrolment Requirements: Students must be at least 15 years of age. They must be able to speak and understand English, and be fit and healthy for climbing. Previous experience lead climbing in single pitch environments is required.

Pre-Course Study: Students are required to complete self study material before starting the course.

Equipment: We encourage students to use their own equipment (provided it is approved by our instructor), so they become familiar with its uses and limitations. We do however supply equipment if you don't have your own.

Qualification: Statement of Attainment that is nationally recognized.

The statement will consist of the following units of competency

SROABA001A - Demonstrate simple abseiling skills on natural surfaces

SROABA003A - Apply single pitch abseiling skills on natural surfaces

SROABA005A - Apply multi pitch abseiling skills on natural surfaces

SROABA004A - Establish ropes for single pitch abseiling on natural surfaces

SROABA006A - Establish ropes for multi pitch abseiling on natural surfaces.

SROCLN001A - Demonstrate simple climbing skills on natural surfaces.

SROCLN002A - Apply climbing skills on natural surfaces

SROCLN003A - Establish belays for climbing on natural surfaces.

SROCLN004A - Apply lead climbing skills on natural surfaces.

SROCLN005A - Apply multi pitch lead climbing skills on natural surfaces

SROVTR001A - Perform vertical rescues

SROVTR002A - Perform complex vertical rescues
