

LEAD CLIMBING – SINGLE PITCH COURSE
NATIONALLY ACCREDITED TRAINING

The lead climbing course is designed to give you the knowledge and skills to climb a route using traditional techniques. Training covers selection of equipment, guide book interpretation, using removable protection (cams, wires, nuts etc), rope management, single rope belay systems, climbing techniques, safety calls and retreating from a route.

Duration: Two (2) days nominal (may vary according to individual aptitude)

Enrolment Requirements: Students must be at least 15 years of age. They must be able to speak and understand English, and be fit and healthy for climbing. Previous top-rope climbing experience is required.

Pre-Course Study: Students are required to complete self study material before starting the course.

Equipment: We encourage students to use their own equipment (provided it is approved by our instructor), so they become familiar with its uses and limitations. We do however supply equipment if you don't have your own. A pen and paper, or a camera is a great way to record the information you will learn.

Qualification: Statement of Attainment that is nationally recognized.

The statement will consist of the following units of competency

SROABA001A - Demonstrate simple abseiling skills on natural surfaces

SROABA003A - Apply single pitch abseiling skills on natural surfaces

SROABA004A - Establish ropes for single pitch abseiling on natural surfaces

SROCLN001A - Demonstrate simple climbing skills on natural surfaces.

SROCLN002A – Apply climbing skills on natural surfaces

SROCLN003A – Establish belays for climbing on natural surfaces.

SROCLN004A – Apply lead climbing skills on natural surfaces.

SROVTR001A - Perform vertical rescues

Endorsements will be listed in addition to these units of competency.
